Request for a Trial in Regard to the Cease and Desist Order from the Japan Fair Trade Commission

The Japan Fair Trade Commission imposed fines on Vantec Corporation for the suspected violation of provisions under Article 3 of the Antimonopoly Act with respect to service charges and fuel surcharges for its international air freight transportation operations.

After careful review of these allegations, Vantec Corporation has decided to request a trial, as the cease and desist order by the Japan Fair Trade Commission is neither fair nor acceptable.

The Japan Fair Trade Commission alleges that Vantec Corporation was violating antitrust laws by fixing fuel surcharges, AMS charges, security charges and bomb test charges for international air freight transportation with other freight companies.

Vantec Corporation seeks a fair judgment because it believes there are conceptual differences between the Japan Fair Trade Commission and Vantec Corporation on this issue.
