## Vantec Europe Awarded New Business In Russia

The contract will start June / July 2013 but we will start to carry out project work with NMUK and NMGR this year.

There will be a significant change in the type of operation when the contract commences in 2013. NMGR will be moving to the NMUK warehouse system which is fundamentally different to the current operation.
